Overnight Parking Spots; 921 and 922 (922L and 922R)

Push back is required upon departure at these spots

Aircraft type allowed to park: up to B763

922L/922R (Spot 922 can be divided into 2 spots)

Aircraft type allowed to park: up to G650

Overnight Parking Spots: 931 - 934 and 941 – 944

Self taxi out is allowed at this series of spots

941

Aircraft type allowed to park: up to Global 5000

932,933,934, 942,943,944

Aircraft type allowed to park: up to G650

931

This spot is assigned to the Japanese Coast Guards, not to be assigned to GA aircraft.

Overnight Parking Spots: 962 - 968

962,963,964,965,966,967,968

Nose-in and push back-out are required at this series of spots.

Aircraft type allowed to park: up to Global 7000

Departure (self taxing out) Spots: 961 and 969

961 and 969 are used only for departure for the aircraft parked at 962-968 if push back out is not preferred. Towing is required to move the aircraft from 962-968 to 961/969. These spots can be used only up to 1 hour before ETD. Advanced coordination is required to use 961 and 969. Tail-in is required.

Overnight Parking Spots: 956 (956L and 956R)


